



Kiwanis rewards sky diver's heroism

Heroism Rewarded — Last April 18, Gregory Robertson, center, of Phoenix, while sky diving at a convention in Coolidge, Ariz., saved the life of fellow sky diver, Debbie Williams.

Williams was knocked unconscious during a free-fall and Robertson dove after her. He finally reached her just 2,000 feet above the ground and was able to release her emergency parachute as well as his own. To honor this feat of bravery, Kiwanis International awarded Robertson its Robert P. Connelly Medal of Heroism during the 69th Annual Kiwanis Southwest District Convention in El Paso, Texas on Aug. 29.
